

Imagery Exercise

Imagery- Vivid appeals to understanding through the senses.

1. Choose an object or a place you wish to portray to the audience. **DO NOT TELL ANYONE ABOUT WHAT YOU ARE WRITING!**
2. Portray this object or place using vivid **IMAGERY**. Don't focus on one of the senses: use all five (sight, smell, touch, taste, and auditory).
3. Write a well-developed paragraph (8 sentences or more) using as many vivid images as possible.
4. Present your paragraph to the class, being careful **NOT** to reveal what the object or the place is.
5. See how many people can guess correctly the object or place.
6. **AUDIENCE:** Write two images of the person's paragraph that appealed the most to your senses. Vote on the best image of the paragraph and add to the list to be hung on the wall.

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
